HipHop/R&B Act "L'NEE" Breaks New Ground

With her 50 Cents Tribute Release, "Sleep When I Die" Critics and Artists agree that Producer, Buggy Hashim delivers an artistic triumph with his hip/hop/R&B angle on L'NEE's tribute album. The idea of the tribute recording has been around for quite awhile, but it's impact and originality has certainly been on the wane.

The initial idea for L'NEE's project started way back. "I'm a dedicated Beyonce maniac," says producer Buggy Hashim and she reminds me a lot like her but with more! "As kids, my older brother and I used to listen to Aretha Franklin and this girl has the vocal skills like her.

L'NEE has been singing since she was 6 years old...L'NEE is the Missy Elliot and Lauryn Hill built into one girl."

Her dedication and lyrical skills are incredible. Engineer Kirk Shearer and Producer Buggy refined and formulated L'NEE's ideas with this album "SLEEP WHEN I DIE". "Buggy states, L'NEE is an extension of something I started in my early teens. However, this time around, I decided to explore a totally different angle in L'NEE's music." When asked, "Why this diverse angle of the music?" Buggy is quick to respond. "Singers cover classics, in order to make them sound modern. Kirt and I were determined to have it go the other way around and not conform to the norm." Buggy began playing with the idea that his versions were the originals - from the past time and today's music - and L'NEE found and recorded his music much later.

Buggy -. "I started asking around, trying to find a music Vocalist that would be willing to turn my crazy idea into a reality. One name kept coming up - Lisa Renee also known as the name I gave her L'NEE!" Apparently, it didn't take too much time to convince her either. "She is the most open-minded, creative and talented person I have ever worked with," he says. L'NEE hails from Orange County, California. She started like most kids watching Michael Jackson and Janet Jackson in the 1980's and 90s. L'NEE is a professional musician, vocalist and writer with years of experience in R&B's finest early music groups. She has toured extensively in the United States. In a time when coming up with an original or creative idea - especially with regards to R&B, Rock and Hip-hop tributes - is all but impossible, L'NEE has seem to have done just that. L'NEE, with all of the attention her album it is getting, it definitely has something going for it, and that something is what it takes to make people go out and buy music in the first place.
